

● **Walk 2. Radwell Ramble**

2.5 miles (4.0 Km) This all-the-year round walk and has three stiles and therefore is not suitable for pushchairs.

Leave the church and head in a westerly direction along Church End to The Old Road. Continue along The Old Road past Pinchmill School, the playing field and Swansholme. Carry straight on until you reach Brook Farm and Parson's Barn at the end of the lane. In very wet weather this area may be muddy. Climb the stile on the right, near the telegraph pole; follow the fence on your left to the next stile. Climb this stile and cross the field, you have the right to roam in this field, to the next stile. Climb the stile and follow the hedge on your left until it ends. At this point turn left and continue following the hedge until you reach a metal kissing gate. Pass through the gate and turn right down the track, cross over the private road, and follow the lane until you reach Moor End Road, Radwell. Turn right and walk through the village until you reach the Felmersham Road. Turn right, continue past the Swan public house and head towards Felmersham until you reach the War Memorial. Carry on down Memorial Lane, at the bottom turn left, and return to the church.

● **Walk 3. Nature Trail**

1.75 miles (2.8 Km) This all-the-year round walk has no stiles.

Whilst walking on the elevated pathway, ensure that you have full control of your children. The pathway is not suitable for pushchairs or wheelchairs.

Leave Felmersham church and follow the main road down the river bridge. Cross the bridge and walk on the elevated pathway until it ends at the

Nature Reserve. Cross the road, and either take the alternative route ● or continue walking (on the right hand side of the road) until you reach the nature reserve car park. Enter the reserve through the gate on the right and carry straight on through the reserve until you reach the far end. Leave the reserve through the kissing gate in the north east corner, turn right and follow the reserve boundary in a southerly direction. At the end of the boundary hedge go through the gate and follow the bridleway over a small bridge and round the headland of a cultivated field before arriving at the river. Follow the bridleway along the river bank and return to Felmersham church which you will see in the distance.

● **Alternative route:** After crossing the road climb the stile in the south west corner of the nature reserve. Follow the path until you reach a bridge over a ditch, at this point turn left and follow the path until you join the regular route.

● **Walk 4. Duke's Way**

1.8 miles (2.9 Km). This 6 month summer walk has no stiles.

Leave the church and head in a westerly direction along Church End, at the Georgian Manor House turn right into Memorial Lane. Carry on past the War Memorial and head towards Radwell. Look for the bridleway sign on the right, opposite the first few bungalows. Follow the bridleway across three fields until you reach the Pavenham road. Turn right and return along the road to Felmersham. In the centre of the village turn right at the T-junction, left at the next intersection, finally ending the walk at the church.
