

"THE BELLS OF ST MARY'S"

Most of you will be too young to remember the film released in 1945 with Ingrid Bergman and Bing Crosby. I actually don't remember seeing the film but I do remember hearing Bing Crosby singing the title song on the "wireless"! The first two lines of the song are *"The bells of St Mary's, Ah! Hear they are calling"* and that dear reader is why I am writing, because currently our bells of St Mary's "ain't calling".



The reason for this is because the eight bells in Felmersham church tower are currently undergoing refurbishment and repair.

Over the years the clappers have developed flats where they strike the bell and this can damage the bell and also affect how the bell sounds.

The header above shows three of the clappers removed from the bells for refurbishing. The photo (left) shows the Revd. Tom standing next to the largest bell, the tenor, which weighs 1052 kgs (just over a one ton). It was cast in 1766 by Joseph Eayers of St Neots and bears the inscription *Cum voco venite* (Come at my call)

Two local church bell experts, Pat Albon and Steve Stanford, have removed the 8 bell clappers and delivered them to Whites of Appleton (Church Bell Specialists) who will refurbish them. The heaviest clapper weighs approximately 2 cwt. so removing them was quite a challenge.

Pat and Steve have also removed the 16 roller bearings on which the 8 bells swing. Removing the bearings is also no mean feat. In order to remove the bearings each bell has to be jacked up and the heaviest bell weighs just over a ton (1052kgs)! The bearings will be replaced with new ones supplied by Whites.

In 1951 the original ring of five bells were re-tuned and augmented into a ring of eight. A new metal frame replaced the old oak frame. All eight bells were re-hung with new fittings and bearings. The clappers were also probably replaced at the same time.

The refurbishment work will take 6 to 8 weeks so the bells and the clock will be silent until mid-February. When the work is completed the bells will ring a lot easier and they will sound "sweeter" and of course the clock will once again start striking the hours.

St Mary's PCC are grateful to Pat and Steve for their free services and also to the Bedford District of the *Bedfordshire Association of Church Bell Ringers* who are donating the cost of the work, which is several thousands of pounds.


