

Joan White, a resident of Felmersham has over the last 19 years been a Neighbourhood Watch volunteer Street Coordinator and at various times also Felmersham's volunteer Area Coordinator. During that period she has seen the official funding and backing for Neighbourhood Watch schemes take a roller coaster ride with the present effort in political circles being to push No or Low Cost schemes such as these.

Joan has now decided the time is right to leave Neighbourhood Watch to others and in a typical helpful final act found a replacement to take her place. I would like to thank Joan for all her past efforts and her help when initially I was one of her street coordinators and more recently she was one of mine.

Many people may not be aware that Neighbourhood Watch is a National scheme with a hierarchy that for us runs from – National, Eastern Region, Bedford and District, Area coordinator, Street coordinators, Residents.

A large part of Felmersham is covered by volunteers helping to run a Neighbourhood Watch scheme. The original idea was that Street coordinators would each cover between 10 and 20 houses. In Felmersham there are only 4 Street coordinators, so additional coordinators are always welcome. We are very lucky in Felmersham that crime is very low and the effort required by the coordinators is very small and long may it stay that way.
