We welcomed to our 'open' May meeting Peter Martin from the East of England Counter Terrorism Unit who spoke to us about a very thought-provoking subject, and seemingly never out of the newspapers these days, "Safeguarding against Terrorism".

You could have heard a pin drop as Peter went on to explain how terrorism is a very real threat to our society in the UK; how it is often the young and vulnerable who are targeted and recruited by terrorist organisations; and how the internet has enabled these groups to reach out to millions with their propaganda. Peter reminded us that the threat of terrorism doesn't just come from Al Qaeda or IS, that there are still home-grown organisations within the UK that will resort to violence and disruption in order to achieve their aims.

The underlying message was that terrorism has been around a long time and, although we need to be careful, vigilant, and promote awareness about the safety of our society, we should also endeavour to remain optimistic for the future.
