Remembrance

Remembrance Sunday is a day 'to commemorate the contribution of British and Commonwealth military and civilian servicemen and women in the two World Wars and later conflicts'.

We are all familiar with the service at the Cenotaph in London. We all watch it with a different perspective. The memories are as varied as the people watching. There are very few people alive now who remember the First World War when families upon families suffered the loss of a son, a daughter, a father. There are later memories from the Second World War: more people learning the dreaded news of the death of a loved one, more misery for so many. The aftermath for thousands was individual agony of mind or of body. Other conflicts have followed, bringing even greater challenges for doctors, nurses and all professionals who strive to help those who return to lives that are no longer normal.

I was born during the war and I remember as a child, watching my mother listening to the service from the Cenotaph with tears streaming down her cheeks; she was German, my father English. They loved each other. Members of different nationalities and different cultures live together in harmony. Why can we not *all* learn to live in that harmony? Why is peace so stubbornly elusive?

On Sunday, 8th November at 10.50am, we will be holding a short service at the War Memorial to remember all those who have died in conflict and especially those who were killed in the two World Wars. After observing the two minute silence, those who wish can join us at St Mary's Church where we will be holding a special remembrance service.

By attending these services we show our gratitude to those whose lives were and are daily put in danger for us. We remember their contribution, their great sacrifice. No-one wants to think of war but it is all around the world and it is up to each one of us to keep striving for peace, even if it is just in our own small way, in our families and in our communities. Never must we lose sight of that goal. We must remember, lest we forget. JR.
