9/11: A Tragedy

As I write the news headlines read as follows "Taliban sweeping across Afghanistan, capturing swathes of territory as isolated government troops surrender" "400,000 Afghans have fled their homes since the start of the year, including almost 300,000 since May".

11th Sept 2021 is the 20th anniversary of the death of over 3000 innocent victims through the destruction of the twin towers in New York by radical idealist extremist terrorists sparking the beginning of the now 20-year Afghan war.

The destruction of the twin towers was a tragedy so globally significant that many will remember exactly what they were doing on that day. For me I was working as a senior executive at Cisco Systems in our European, Middle East and Africa headquarters in London, discussing long term internet strategy with some of our largest international government partners, when the giant screens in our executive briefing centre lit up with live pictures of the North tower burning and the second aeroplane being flown into 60th floor of the South Tower. Our meeting fell into silence. Our gaze was fixed on the screen. In seeking solace and answers our stares slowly moved from the unspeakable horror on the giant screens into each other's eyes. Nothing was said for what appeared to be an eternity, until as chair of the meeting I quietly suggested we pause our discussion and adjourn.

Tragedy has a way of silencing our hearts, minds and souls, not with a peaceful



stillness, but with a turbulent emptiness that dizzies the senses and mangles our thoughts. Tragedy that seems to come from nowhere and which inflicts undeserved brutal suffering and injustice on innocent victims always demands a response. When wounded by such events some take stock and plan a proportionate response that seeks to address the injustice. For some the answer is simply to rapidly retaliate with angry force, matching brutality with brutality. Answers to such real and tragic dilemmas are not easy to formulate and impossible to get right.

The suffering for the now hundreds of thousands from the consequences of the events of 9/11 are clear to see in the news headlines and continue not just for the Afghan people, but also for the families of the victims of the twin towers tragedy, who are spread across the world. It is often missed that the victims of the twin towers came from over 90 countries.

None of us are exempt from tragedy in our lives. We live in an imperfect and fallen world that will inevitably deliver some form of tragedy. Solace in this may be difficult to find but learning is never far away if we wish to find it.

We know that violence escalates violence, and that any response to tragedy must always be proportional to the outcome it seeks to achieve and yet 20 years on war still rages on in Afghanistan and in many other places.

As we try and formulate our answers, we may consider with realism that in an imperfect world we will have times of war and peace (Ecclesiastes 3:8) but also that this is not our permanent state. We are promised a hope that a time is coming when God "will judge between the nations and will settle disputes for many peoples. They will beat their swords into ploughshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore" (Isaiah 2:4). May this be our hope and prayer for the people of Afghanistan and for the many people in other places of war across the world.

"We pray for all whose lives have been touched by tragedy, whether by accident or a deliberate act.

For those who mourn, immerse them in your love and lead them through this darkness into your arms, and light.

For those who comfort, be in both the words they use and all that's left unspoken; fill each heart with love.

We ask this through Jesus Christ, whose own suffering brought us life, here and for eternity. Amen". ©John Birch

The Village Hall Committee held their first 'in person' meeting in July and everyone agreed that it was nice to get together again after holding Zoom meetings for the previous 12 months. Here is an update of what has been on the agendas:

Committee Room We had a leak in the roof earlier this year which has been repaired temporarily but unfortunately means there is a hole in the committee room ceiling. We are waiting to hear from Bedford Borough Council's insurers as to whether we can make a claim to cover the repair costs or if we will have to cover the costs ourselves.

We were eligible for the Government Covid grants for village halls so this has covered our loss of income and boosted our bank balance so are hoping this won't be wiped out by any repair costs.

Covid Due to the pandemic we have been unable to hire out the hall until recently but now have some our regular hirers returning.

The park is checked weekly by the committee members and recently we have found some offensive graffiti (again) which we are hoping to have removed soon.


