

Four Family Walks Based on Felmersham

These four walks have been specially devised to meet the needs of parents with young families and may also be suitable for people with limited mobility. They are all circular walks starting and finishing at St Mary's Church, Felmersham.

The walks are relatively easy going with either no stiles or a limited number of stiles. Some of the walks are usable all the year round whilst others are only suitable during the summer.

Please observe the Highway Code and Country Code.

● Walk 1. Baker's Lane

1.3 miles (2.1 Km) This all-the-year round walk has no stiles and is suitable for pushchairs. Leave the church and head in a westerly direction along Church End to The Old Road. Continue along The Old Road past Pinchmill School, the playing field and Swansholme until you reach a corrugated barn. Turn right at the bridleway sign and follow the track up a gentle incline (known as Baker's Lane) until you reach a private road (known as the Concrete Road). Turn right onto the road, which at this point is also a bridle way and carry on past two white cottages until you meet the Felmersham to Radwell road. (The cottages were built in 1827 and are known as Dropshort. They were originally used as a workhouse.) At the Felmersham road turn right and follow the footpath towards Felmersham until you reach the War Memorial. Carry on down Memorial Lane, at the bottom turn left, and return to the church.
